1. SUMMARY OF ACCOUNITING POLICIES

The accounting policies adopted by the association are stated in order to assist in a general understanding of the financial statements. These policies have been consistently applied except as otherwise indicated.

Reporting entity

Goods & Services Tax (GST)

The association is of the opinion that it is not subject to good & services tax. As a non-profit organization with an annual turnover of less than \$100,000 per annum, the association is not required to register for GST. The Executive Committee has therefore, decided not to register for GST. As a result, the association cannot include GST in the price of its services and is not able to claim GST credits in the price of goods and services it buys in carrying on its activities.
